Thermal expansion is large for gases, and relatively small, but not negligible, for liquids and solids. Linear thermal expansion is  $\Delta L = \alpha L \Delta T$ , where  $\Delta L$  is the change in length  $L$ ,  $\Delta T$  is the change in temperature, and  $\alpha$  is the coefficient of linear expansion, which varies slightly with temperature.

That is, liquids flow (so they are a type of fluid), with the molecules held together by mutual attraction. When a liquid is placed in a container with no lid, it remains in the container. Because the atoms are closely packed, liquids, like solids, resist compression; an extremely large force is necessary to change the volume of a liquid.
